FOSTERS: Fosters do not have custody of the animal. You are a volunteer providing a service a t your request. All rescues remain the sole property of Road Dogg Rescue (According to Florida Law) until RESCUE Animal is adopted. If you do not feel you can do the job, please do not hesitate to return the dog to us.

ADOPTERS: As with the fosters, dogs remain property of Road Dogg Rescue until adoption papers are signed in person(s) wanting to adopt have agreed to the contractual agreement. Any money spent on said Pet while in your custody is a donation. Unless request is made within reason for ANY item, it will be provided for through the rescue. All rescues (pets, animals) will be financially cared for through Road Dogg Rescue.

ADOPTERS, PLEASE BE PREPARED TO TAKE YOUR DOG HOME: CRATE, HALTER, LEASH, FOOD AND BOWLS FOR WATER. THIS WILL HELP YOUR FIRST DAYS TOGETHER RUN MORE SMOOTHLY. ALWAYS HAVE YOUR DOG ON A LEASH WHEN TRAVELING OR WALKING. EVEN FOR A SHORT PERIOD. EVERYTHING IS NEW TO THEM, SO GIVE THEM TIME TO ADJUST. Crates are not to be used for punishment or to get them out of your way. If you find that your pet is put into the crate for more hours than you spend with him/her, please return the animal for his/her own sake. We are of the mindset that all our rescues be members of the family and should be treated as such. If at any time, this is not what you signed for, no one is going to fault you. We take all our rescues back and find loving homes for them. THINK BEFORE YOU ADOPT. They are not possessions or cool things to have. They are living beings that, by default, are dependent upon us to take care of their every need. If you do not feel you can provide what the pet needs at this time, be honest and wait until you are ready.

## DOG ADOPTION CONTRACT/AGREEMENT

Please initial items 1 – 12. Road Dogg Rescue, Inc. (the "Charity/Rescue/we/us"), a Florida

501 (c) (3) non-profit corporation, and the Undersigned (the "Adopter" or "you"), in consideration of the mutual covenants in this Agreement and other good and valuable consideration, intending to be legally bound by this Agreement, agree to the following: \_\_\_\_ 1. **The Dog**: We are placing the following described dog/puppy with you, the Adopter, for the adoption by you as a companion dog and family member. \_\_ 2. **Adoption Fee**: The Adopter agrees to pay a non-refundable fee of \$ \_\_\_\_\_. Your adoption fee includes spay/neuter, microchip and vaccines current to the age of the dog/puppy. Any vaccines due after the adoption are the financial responsibility of the Adopter. 3. **Spay/Neuter**: If this "Dog" has not been sterilized prior to this agreement, you agree to Spay or Neuter within 6 months of this signed agreement. Please call us to arrange sterilization. You understand that this contract is not final until the spay or neuter is complete. If sterilization is not completed within this timeframe, we reserve the right to remove the animal from your care. 4. **Veterinary Care**: You agree to provide all necessary medical care to the "Dog" in a timely manner. You agree to keep all vaccinations current and ensure the dog receives preventative medication to protect against fleas, ticks & heartworm. Any veterinary problems that may arise, including serious illness requiring emergency care or surgery is your responsibility and you are responsible for all related costs. All of our pets are updated on vaccines, dewormed and flea treated. They are treated for any medical needs. To the best of our knowledge, we are giving you a healthy pet unless otherwise noted. 5. **Obedience Training**: Adopter agrees to provide obedience training for the "Dog" at their cost if any behavior issues arise. 6. **Behavioral Issues**: (i.e., biting, destruction, escapism, fearfulness, dominance) that might lead to abandonment of the animal: Adopter agrees to contact an obedience trainer as well as Road Dogg Rescue, Inc. to follow the recommendations in resolving any issues as an effort to maintain custody of the adopted animal. \_\_\_\_\_ 7. **Identification**: You agree that the "Dog" will always be wearing an identification tag with your current telephone number. If not possible, the microchip registered to the animal must be updated and maintained.

8. <b>Return Policy</b> : If Adopter decides to not keep the "Dog", Adopter hereby agrees to return the "Adoptee" to the Rescue within 14 days. Adopter agrees to give the Rescue up to 30 days to secure a foster home and will provide safe and loving care of the Dog until it is returned.
9. <b>No Warranty</b> : Rescue makes no warranty as to the temperament or physical condition of the "Adoptee". The "Adoptee" is being adopted as is. All warranties with regard to "Adoptee", including any implied warranty of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, where they are applicable, are hereby specifically disclaimed.
10. <b>Release &amp; Indemnification/No Liability</b> : Adopter hereby releases Road Dogg Rescue, Inc. from any and all liability for personal injury, property damage, legal fees, or veterinary care, or any other expense or liability incurred by Adopter as a result of this adoption. Adopter agrees to indemnify Road Dogg Rescue, Inc. from any and all such claims and to pay, without limitation, any costs related to such injury, damage, or liability, including, in the case of litigation, any attorney's fees incurred by Road Dogg Rescue, Inc. in its defense.
11. <b>Breach of Agreement/Liquidated Damages</b> : In the event that you do not comply with the terms of this Agreement, or the Dog is abused or neglected, we hold the right to recover the Dog from you upon demand, and the Dog will be surrendered to us immediately.
12. Entire Agreement/Modification/Binding Effect: This Agreement (including the attached Voluntary Release/Waiver of Liability) is the entire agreement between you and us, and supersedes any prior understandings between you and us with respect to the subject matter of this agreement. No modification of this Agreement will be valid unless in writing duly signed by both you and us. This Agreement is binding upon you and your heirs, assigns, successors, personal representatives and executors.
